Congressman Tony Gonzales

Tony Gonzales is a 20-year veteran of the United States Navy, who rose to the Navy's highest rank of Master Chief Petty Officer. An accomplishment that less than 1% of enlisted individuals achieve. During Tony's time in service, he was deployed multiple times in support of combat operations to Iraq (Operation Iraqi Freedom) and Afghanistan (Operation Enduring Freedom), and in support of regional security operations throughout Asia. He was on the front lines facing the most serious of situations an individual can face.

Aaron Kendle

Mr. Kendle is a retired Navy SEAL where he served as a specialized medic, sniper, airborne leader, and jump school instructor. He is a graduate of the Harvard Business school, a father, a husband and a Scottsdale Charro. Mr. Kendle is a decorated member of the United States Navy, served as a member of SEAL Team 7, NSWG-1 Training Detachment, and Naval Special Warfare Development over a 15-year career and has dedicated his post-military career to helping his fellow brothers in arms transition back into civilian life.



Sydney Negley Mulder



Sydney Negley Mulder became a passionate advocate for Sound Off after personally witnessing her husband's struggles with the mental health care system, specifically in the military. She experienced the tragedy of Veteran suicide first hand when her husband, Bill, died by suicide only 5 months after leaving a decorated 20 year career in Naval Special Warfare. Sydney courageously shares her story and Bill's to raise awareness for suicide prevention. Her hope is to share Bill's life and legacy and to continue to make their three children proud.
